Carriage for Forklift

Carriages - Rated by the fork carriage hoisting capacity, there are four sizings of hook type tine carriages. The hook type tine carriages have been standardized.

Class I carriages are rated for cargo up to 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for Class I is thirteen inches. Class II carriages are rated for loads up to 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads as much as 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this class is 20 inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for this capacity is twenty five inches.

Pin mounted blades vary by the amount of offset between the tine and the tine eye. Some manufacturers will differ the carriages for pin type tines. Carriage capacity will be determined by the carriage pin size and by the fork size.
